HISTORY OF THE ENDOWMENT FUND

In 1993, the St. Ann Endowment Fund was established to benefit the parish with a perpetual stream of income that would increase over time, with additions and growth, and to have a profound impact on parish finances and programs for generations to come. The Endowment Fund has grown to almost \$1.5 million due to the many faithful parishioners who have left a gift to St. Ann, provided a donation upon enrollment in St. Ann School, attended the St. Ann Fall Festival where a portion of the proceeds benefits the fund or from families who have directed memorial gifts to the Endowment in memory of a loved one. Because the Endowment Fund is a permanent fund, only the earnings are distributed for actual use. Distributions from the Endowment Fund are made bi-annually to benefit the parish and school.
