2. Archdiocesan Capital Campaign - Michaela provided the campaign target & block assignment for St. Ann as part of the Capital Campaign.

- The block assignment for St. Ann – Block 2, beginning in January of 2019.
- Campaign target for St. Ann - \$1,910,000.00

3. Haiti

- Mr. Joe Weaver of CRS spoke at only the Sunday Masses on March 4th. He was not able to make it to Saturday, March 3rd. He spoke about CRS and his experience. The talk seemed to be well received by the feedback heard. This was a general introduction into Catholic Relief Services.
- Rachel Gelhaus will contact Theresa Dunbar to check on her or her designee, availability to speak at all the Masses either 4/21 & 4/22 or 4/28 & 4/29. This presentation will be specific to Haiti.
